Gather to Go:: Healing & God's Purposes

Passage: Acts 9:32-43

The Point: God provides Healing but His purposes are often different from ours.

Discussion Questions:

- The sermon's main idea was: "God provides healing, but His purposes are often different from ours." How does that challenge or encourage the way you think about prayer, healing and suffering?
- In both healings, God blessed individuals but also used the miracles to point others to Jesus. How can our stories of healing, help, or endurance become a witness to others?
- Why is it important to remember that Jesus understands suffering, grief, abandonment, and pain?
- When you are suffering, do you tend to ask God "Why?" more than "Where are You in this?" What might change if you began asking where God is working?
- How have you experienced God's presence in a difficult season, even if the outcome was not what you prayed for?
- The sermon said that healing can come miraculously, progressively, or ultimately in eternity. How does that broaden our view of God's care?
- What makes it difficult to keep trusting and praying when healing or deliverance does not come quickly?
- Who might need to hear your story of how God has comforted, sustained, or provided for you?
- What was your biggest takeaway and/or what is one concrete step you sense God inviting you to take this week?
