Everyday: A Life Devoted to Jesus

Passage: Galatians 2:20

The Point: Bringing Gospel Restoration into our everyday lives as we live devoted to Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

- **Intro:**
 - When you hear the phrase “a life devoted to Jesus,” what comes to mind?
 - What is the danger of thinking that following Jesus is like levels of Netflix subscriptions?
- **Devotion to Jesus begins with Grace**
 - Why is it important to understand that devotion to Jesus begins with grace and not effort?
 - How does getting this wrong distort the gospel?
- **Devotion to Jesus is personal**
 - Paul repeatedly uses “I” and “me” in Galatians 2:20. Why do you think devotion to Jesus must be deeply personal and not inherited from family, church culture, or tradition?
- **Devotion to Jesus will reshape your life**
 - Paul begins Galatians 2:20 with a crucified life. Why does Paul emphasize this first?
 - Why do you think many people want the new life Jesus offers without the death He requires? What are the dangers of trying to hold onto both?
 - What will it look like practically to live by faith in Jesus?
- **Devotion to Jesus is motivated by love**
 - Paul says his devotion is motivated by the fact that Jesus “loved me and gave Himself for me.” How does remembering Christ’s love reshape our motivation for obedience?
- **Practical Application:**
 - What are some everyday situations where Jesus is currently inviting you to deny yourself? How might obedience there reshape your heart?
 - Why are having godly people & friends imperative when living devoted to Jesus?
 - When you fail or stumble spiritually, do you tend to run toward Jesus or pull away from Him?
 - What was your biggest takeaway from the message?
