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## COMMUNITY GROUP GUIDE

### Everyday Disciple-Maker:: Discipleship & Obedience

Passage: Matthew 28:18-20

The Point: Making disciples requires obedience.

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#### Discussion Questions:

- **Opening:**
  - When you hear “Great Commission,” what emotion pops up first—excitement, guilt, confusion, fear? Why?
- **The Authority of Jesus**
  - Read v.18. How does “all authority in heaven and on earth” change the way you hear the command that follows?
  - What could cause us to treat the Great Commission more like a suggestion than a commission?
- **Make Disciples:**
- **1) Be Intentional**
  - What hinders us from being intentional in making disciples in our everyday life?
  - “Go” implies movement and initiative. Where do you already go (live/work/play) that could become intentional mission ground?
- **2) Encourage people to follow Jesus**
  - What are some barriers or hinderance you face in sharing your faith with others?
  - What are some practical ways that you can encourage people to follow Jesus?
- **3) Teach people to follow Jesus**
  - Who are some people that have help you follow Jesus? What methods did they use that you could copy?
  - Where is the most practical place to start teaching and discipling people in your life right now?
- **How to be Obedient:**
- **1) Stir Affections**
  - What are some things that causes your love for Jesus to grow cold?
  - Since obedience flows from love. What are some things that help you to stir your affections for Jesus?
- **2) Be Available**
  - What hinders you from being “available” in your everyday life?
  - How can you foster a posture of availability to make disciples?
  - What was your biggest takeaway from the message?
