## **COMMUNITY GROUP GUIDE**

### **Gather to Go: Empowered for the Mission**

Passage: Acts 1:1-11

The Point: We are called to continue the mission of Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit.

#### **Discussion Questions:**

- Why does it matter that the book of Acts is our history as the church, not just information about the early church? How does that change the way we read and apply it?
- The sermon said we should approach Acts as participants, not just admirers. What does it look like in real life to participate in the mission of Acts rather than just study it?
- Read Acts 1:8. It says we are called to be witnesses, not just to do witnessing. How does that shift the pressure or expectations you feel about sharing your faith?
- A witness speaks from firsthand experience. What is one way you have personally experienced Gospel restoration that you could share with someone else?
- Jesus names Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth as our places to go witness. Who and where might represent those places in your everyday life right now?
- Acts shows that the Spirit produces both bold witness and transformed living. Which of those do you feel God is inviting you to grow in more right now?
- The sermon emphasized dependence on the Holy Spirit, especially through prayer. What does your current prayer life reveal about what you're depending on?
- If Acts is still being lived out through the church today, what might it look like for God to use your life to carry the mission of Jesus this week?
- What was your biggest takeaway from the message?
